TEMPORARY STANDING ORDER REGARDING CORONAVIRUS DISEASE (COVID-19) MITIGATION AND ALL JUSTICES OF THE PEACE IN HILL COUNTY (Order No.01)

Due to coronavirus disease (COVID-19), the Justices of the Peace in Hill County issue the following order based on the Office of the Court of Administration's "Updated Guidance #1 on Court procedures for the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19)." This order is issued to protect the community, limit exposure, and provide for an efficient judicial system:

If the office of Court Administration issues updated guidance, the Justices of the Peace will amend this order accordingly. All scheduled court proceedings before April 1, 2020, except for "essential court proceedings" will be reset to another date after April 1, 2020. Each court will contact the litigants to notify them of the new reset date as soon as practicable for the court. Essential court proceedings are writs of re-entry, writs of retrieval, writs of restoration, magistration of defendants in custody, and of fugitives from justice.

As well as repair and remedy cases that materially affect the physical health or safety of a tenant.

For traffic/Class C citations with an appearance date before April 1, 2020, the appearance date will be extended. Each court can modify this order depending upon circumstances as the current situation changes.
